National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS)

The NDIS is in your community. What is the NDIS?

The NDIS is a new way of providing disability support. The NDIS supports people with disability to build skills and capability so they can participate in the community and employment. The NDIS is facilitated by the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA).

The NDIS has been set up to ensure people with disability have CHOICE. They have a choice in choosing their goals, who will assist them in working towards their goals (generally a disability services provider like NWRH) and how often this assistance will take place.

Maintain your informal support arrangements

Who can access services under the NDIS?

If you have a permanent disability and meet the program eligibility criteria you can access the NDIS.

NWRH HAVE A CHECKLIST TO ASSIST YOU IN CONFIRMING ELIGIBILITY.

It's important to understand how the NDIS works and whether you are eligible to participate. If you are, you will develop a plan with the NDIS to help you access the supports you need. Your plan will be reviewed over time so you'll get the right support for as long as you need it.

* Please note that people must lodge their access request before their 65th birthday in order to meet the NDIS eligibility requirements. Once you are registered with NDIS you can choose to transition to the My Aged Care Program after you turn 65 or stay with NDIS.

How can I access NDIS Supports?

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CONTACT NDIA

The NDIA is the first point to contact to access the scheme and receive services



PLANNING

An NDIA planner will assist you to identify your goals and what services you need to achieve these goals

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FINALISE PLAN

It may take a few discussions and changes, but once happy you finalise your plan and budget with the NDIA



CHOOSE PROVIDER

You can now choose which service provider you would like to deliver the services in your plan

What NDIS Supports do NWRH Offer?

- Assistance in coordinating or managing life stages, transitions and supports

- Accommodation/ Tenancy assistance
- Assistive products for personal care and safety
- Physical wellbeing activities

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Physical Wellbeing Activities & Therapeutic Services

- » Occupational Therapists
- » Exercise Physiology
- » Physiotherapy
- » Podiatry Feet & Footwear including nail care manage and foot conditions that may make walking painful or difficult
- » Speech Therapy Support for people with speaking or swallowing/eating difficulties
- » Dietitian Help with correct diet and food choices

- » Develop strategies to assist maintaining continence
- » Deciding on and sourcing aids such as pads
