Disclaimer – It is important for Service Users to recognise that once approved by My Aged Care to receive services through the Commonwealth Home Support Programme or Home Care Package, NWRH may not automatically be approved as your service provider unless you specifically request NWRH. A service provider will be assigned dependent on your needs.

COMMONWEALTH HOME SUPPORT PROGRAMME

If you are an older person aged 65 years or over (or 50 years and over for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people) who requires entry-level support services to continue living independently and safely at home; you may be eligible for this support.

Commonwealth Home Support Programme (CHSP) works with you to help maintain your independence rather than doing things for you. CHSP can also support your carer and arrange someone to help you with everyday tasks.

HOME CARE PACKAGES

Home Care Packages are for those with greater or more complex care needs.

Home care Packages support people who need a higher level of care and support services on an ongoing basis. Support provided goes beyond what the Commonwealth Home Support Programme can provide.

WHAT IS A HOME CARE PACKAGE?

Home Care Packages can be an option if you need a coordinated approach to the delivery of your help at home. Upon assessment, you may be assigned a Home Care Package which has four levels of support assisting you with the care, services and supports you need to meet your goals and keep you living independently at home.

What types of services are provided through

GOODS, EQUIPMENT AND HOME MODIFICATIONS

 To help increase or maintain your ability to move around your home safely and independently

SOCIAL SUPPORT

- To help you remain social and interact with your community



MEALS AND FOOD PREPARATION

-To help ensure that you continue to eat well



CARE COORDINATION AND MANAGEMENT

 To support you by linking your services together and coordinating your care needs and goals

QUEENSLAND COMMUNITY SUPPORT SCHEME

The Queensland Community Support Scheme (QCSS) provides low intensity supports to assist you to live independently, increase connections and participate in your local community.

Eligible people:

- Under 65 years old (or under 50 years old for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people)
- Those not eligible for NDIS

Community Services can support you by:

- Improving your capacity to self-manage and live more independently in your home
- Reduce social isolation through opportunities to connect with others and participate in your community
- Connect you with other programs, supports and services to best meet your needs

COMMUNITY TRANSPORT PROGRAM

The Community Transport Program supports people who have trouble accessing transport options to get around their local community.

You may have trouble accessing transport because of:

- Where you live
- Your financial situation
- Disability, mental health or chronic health conditions

Community Services provide support with:

- Wheelchair accessible bus
- Transport services available Monday Friday

Eligible people:

- Under 65 years old (or under 50 years old for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people)
- Those not eligible for NDIS
- Are an unpaid carer
- Have limited or no access to other transport options
